Lifestar responded to 55 911 calls for the month of January in the CAEMS area that were paged out via Columbia County Dispatch.

Lifestar failed to meet the response guidelines for three calls in the month of January. On 1/13/20, Lifestar was requested for a call in the City of Columbus. There was a short delay due to poor winter road conditions. On 1/14/20, Lifestar was requested for a call in the City of Columbus. The responding crew initially responded to the wrong road name. This crew was coached on the importance of knowing where they are responding to. On 1/25/20 Lifestar was requested for a call in the Town of Elba. The page information that was received from Dodge and Columbia counties were not the same address. This caused confusion of the first responding ambulance. The first responding ambulance ended up getting stuck due to poor winter road conditions. A second ambulance was then requested to respond as the first responding ambulance was unable to free themselves and required a tow truck to remove the ambulance from the snow.
