Lifestar responded to 58 911 calls this month that were paged out via Columbia County Dispatch. Lifestar was also requested for mutual aid by Rio EMS four times with three of our four responses being cancelled en route. Lifestar was also requested for a paramedic intercept with Cambria EMS and Pardeeville EMS. Lifestar also provided fire stand-by support for Reeseville FD, Fall River FD, and Columbus FD

Lifestar was able to dedicate three ambulances to the drill while still having one available for real-life calls. The 4th of July celebration drew a large number of people to the Columbus area as usual. All events went well with no celebration related emergencies.
