Lifestar responded to 58 911 calls this month that were paged out via Columbia County Dispatch. Of those calls five of them were fire stand-by calls with Columbus Fire and one fire stand0by with Fall River Fire.

Below is the breakdown by municipality:

- City of Columbus – 27
- Village of Fall River – 9
- Town of Calamus – 5
- Town of Columbus – 2
- Town of Elba – 6
- Town of Fountain Prairie – 3
- Town of Hampden – 3
- Town of Portland – 2
- Town of Otsego – 0

Lifestar failed to meet the response guidelines on three separate 911 calls for the month of March. On 3/1, Lifestar responded into the City of Columbus. The caller had stated that they requested no lights and sirens and there was difficulty with the responding crew to locate the correct apartment. On 3/15, Lifestar was paged with Fall River Fire for a fire call. Both Lifestar ambulances were already out on separate 911 calls when the fire call came in and mutual aid was requested from Rio EMS. Once a Lifestar ambulance cleared from the hospital, they responded to the fire scene and released Rio EMS to return to their service area. On 3/24 Lifestar was requested to respond with Columbus Fire for a fire call. The responding ambulance responded to the address given by COSO Dispatch but further investigation found the fire call to be at a different location within the City of Columbus. Once the correct location was identified, the responding ambulance went to the correct address and was released shortly after arrival by Columbus Fire command. Lifestar also responded to two separate multi-vehicle crashes with multiple patients. Both crashes were serviced solely by Lifestar and all injuries were minor.
