Lifestar responded to 78 911 calls for the month of June in the CAEMS area that were paged out via Columbia County Dispatch. Lifestar provided paramedic intercept service for Rio EMS twice and for Cambria EMS once. Lifestar also provided mutual aid to Marshall EMS once and requested mutual aid from Rio EMS once.
